The Emperor's library, which is located in the Petits Appartements of the Château de Fontainebleau, has been re stored, both in terms of its furniture and the books which are kept there. It holds a great number of books on history, geography and military art, which were Napoleon I's favourite topics, as he used his library as a working tool above all. An avid reader, the Emperor was also keen on literature, theatre, ancient and classical authors as well as philosophy. He wished to keep up with French and European intellectual life and expected his librarian t o provide him with the latest releases.

You will be able to appreciate the Emperor's restored library in a guided tour of the Petits Appartements of the E mperor and Empresses Josephine and Marie-Louise.
